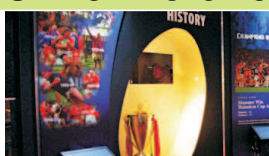

First Stop: Ailwee Caves



Let the staff at AILLWEE CAVE welcome you to the dramatic underworld of the Burren.

Expert guides will accompany and inform you during your leisurely tour.

The tour consists of a 30 minute stroll through the beautiful caverns – over bridged chasms, under weird formations and alongside the thunderous waterfall which sometimes gently sprays the unsuspecting visitor! Unique Cave Features Marvel at the frozen waterfall and explore the now extinct brown bears bones (ursos arctos).

Then experience the unique Birds of Prey centre, featuring the **LARGEST** and most varied collection of Birds of Prey in Ireland. Learn about the ancient art of Falconry & raise awareness of indigenous species and the environmental issues involved in their protection and conservation.



Second Stop: Cliffs of Moher



The Cliffs of Moher are one of Ireland's top Visitor attractions and are a designated UNESCO Geo Park. The Cliffs are 214m high at the highest point and range for 8 kilometres over the Atlantic Ocean on the western seaboard of County Clare. From the Cliffs one can see the Aran Islands, Galway Bay, as well as The Twelve Pins, the Maum Turk Mountains in Connemara and Loop Head to the South.

ATLANTIC EDGE is the exciting interpretive centre at the Cliffs of Moher New Visitor Experience. Housed at the centre of the underground building a huge domed cave contains images, exhibits, displays & experiences that will delight young and old alike.



Third Stop: Liscannor Rock Shop



End the tour with a visit to the enchanting Liscannor Rock Shop and view the amazing audio visual presentation on local quarrying methods used through the ages with unique mind blowing shots of the Cliffs of Moher. Browse shelves packed full of earth's natural treasures, crystals and fossils.

The **Aqua Dome** is a safe, fun-filled place to visit for a memorable school tour day out. It has many exciting features which are thrilling & fun for school tour children of all ages. You can "Fly down the 90 meter flume slide", "Ride the outdoor raging rapids", "Body surf in the waves", "Swim effortlessly in the Castle river rapids" or simply "Relax in the lazy river". Gushers, Geysers, and Water jets, all add to the thrills and spills of an exciting school tour day out.



Aqua Golf is located alongside the Aqua Dome and consists of an exciting 18 hole mini-golf course which is great fun for school tours of all ages. The Aqua Golf is set in a beautifully landscaped environment incorporating water features, a cave & a 40 foot high water fountain. Discover why Daniel O'Connell fought a duel and understand what drove Tom Crean to risk his life repeatedly in the most desolate place on earth in the award winning Antarctica Exhibition.

Travel back in time to the Middle Ages where a stroll through the **Medieval Experience** reveals the streets of Tralee as they were in 1450. when Tralee was the capital of the powerful Desmond Geraldines. It was a thriving market town with a Castle and Monastery. The town was protected by a high wall and Irish is the spoken language of the people. This is the setting for your fascinating visit to medieval Ireland.



As students stroll through the medieval streets and houses with a series of fun questions they will discover what people wore, the food they ate and where they lived. Special sound, lighting and odour effects make this an experience to remember.

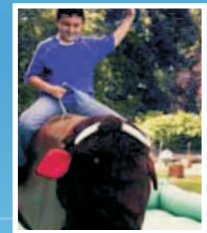

Please ensure to observe instructions at each attraction.

Please follow the instructions of the bus driver and staff at each attraction.

Seatbelts **MUST** be worn at all times.

Do not leave your seat once the bus has started moving.

Recommended supervision levels are:

1 adult for every 6 children under 8.

1 adult for every 10-15 children 8 to 10 years old.

1 adult for every 15-20 children 11 years and upwards.

Supervisors should sit around the coach (not all together in a group) preferably with one person close to each emergency exit.

Booking:

All bookings must be made in advance. Please give as much notice as possible.

We will endeavour to accommodate requested tour dates but we cannot guarantee your chosen date will be available.

Payment needs to be made in advance.

Please note, the Tayto Park tour requires a 25% deposit when booking.
